



## **COVID 19 Vaccination Policy**

The purpose of the COVID-19 Vaccination Policy is to protect and support the health and safety of the LaSalle College Community including the University's faculty, staff, and students.

As July 21, all staff and some teachers of Lasalle College Jakarta (LCJ) has received vaccinations. Some of them has received first dose and will be joining the second one in this August 21.

Align with government program regarding acceleration of COVID 19 vaccination, starting this July 21, LaSalle College Jakarta strongly encourage students to obtain COVID 19 vaccination when you are eligible. Students must be aware that unvaccinated or incomplete vaccination are at higher risk of worse effect of falling ill.

Following are policy details:

- LaSalle College Jakarta (LCJ) is prioritizing students who has obtained COVID 19 vaccination at least the first dose for campus visits particularly for attending limited practical courses.
- Students who have obtained COVID 19 vaccination have to provide written documentation of vaccination from external (e.g., at a private health care provider's office or during a vaccine fair),
- Students who have NOT obtained COVID 19 vaccination are required to fill out unvaccinated or incomplete vaccination consent form and submit to academic department.
- Students who have NOT obtained COVID 19 vaccination are required to show negative result of rapid swab anti gen testing every two weeks for campus visit.
